Alex writes for theatre, film & TV and performs musical comedy. His debut feature screenplay, 'The Lesson', was released by Universal and Bleecker Street in 2023. Starring Richard E Grant, Julie Delpy and Daryl McCormack, the film was a New York Times Critic's Pick and described by Stephen King as 'Cold, smart and suspenseful... Excellent acting and a nicely timed twist at the end.' For the script, Alex was longlisted for a BIFA for Best Debut Screenwriter. His first play, 'School Play', ran at the Southwark Playhouse to national critical acclaim and was published by Bloomsbury. As a comedian, he won the 2020 Musical Comedy Awards and took his debut solo show, 'Thanks for Listening', to the Edinburgh Fringe in 2022. Chortle described the show as 'Funny, atmospheric, sometimes gently ludicrous, sometimes rooted in reality and sometimes a little of both.' It enjoyed a sellout run and transferred to London's Soho Theatre. Recently, Alex was a semi-finalist in the BBC New Comedy Awards 2023, and worked in the writers room for seasons one and two of the BBC3 comedy-drama 'Boarders'. He is currently writing an episode for the second season 'The Completely Made-Up Adventures of Dick Turpin' for Big Talk and Apple TV+, and developing an original comedy series, 'Freelance', with Baby Cow Productions.
