Anna Jones Davall is a writer/ director.

Her web series, MY AMERICA (co-written with Jamel Davall Rodriguez) was described by Thought Catalog as “the series everyone should watch before the election” and was an official selection at the LA Film Festival, HollyShorts and SeriesFest, Colorado. They have various projects in development (including their two children!) alongside a feature Anna is writing.

Anna has directed numerous shorts, including THE MECHANICALS OF HEMP (with Harry Enfield, Cara Horgan and Charity Wakefield); THE GREAT UNKNOWN (with Olympia Dukakis); the NOW WHAT? trilogy for Brooklyn Seoul Productions and the award-winning NO STRINGS for Steam Media & Middle G Productions based on a poem by actress Emily Bevan (Sky’s FUNNY WOMAN), seen in the official selection at the London Short Film Festival among others in the UK and US. She also directed and exec produced DEATH OVER DINNER, a set of documentary shorts for Topic/First Look Productions. Anna was a BAFTA LA Newcomer and has been a finalist for the Genesis Future Director’s Award and The JMK Award. Anna also works in the theatre in the UK and US, primarily directing devised work and new writing. Anna was born in London and studied at Cambridge University and the Yale School of Drama where she was a recipient of the Eldon Elder award. There, she collaborated with Alena Smith (Apple TV’s DICKINSON) and Tarell McCraney (MOONLIGHT) among many others.
