Lucy Pardee won a BAFTA, a BIFA and a Critics' Circle award for casting eight-times BAFTA-nominated feature ROCKS, for which she notably populated the lead cast with young people who had never acted before, and who the story is shaped around. The lead Bukky Bakray won the rising star BAFTA.

Lucy found lead Katie Jarvis for Andrea Arnold's 2009 FISH TANK, who starred opposite Michael Fassbender, and cast Arnold's 2016 BAFTA-nominated AMERICAN HONEY.

Lucy specialises in street casting and long term script research, and has worked with some of the most critically acclaimed filmmakers in the country.
