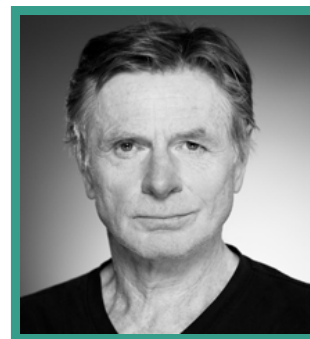


David Beames
