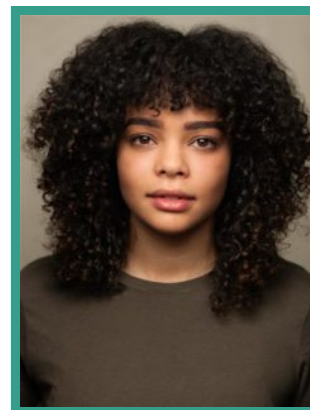


Lydia West
