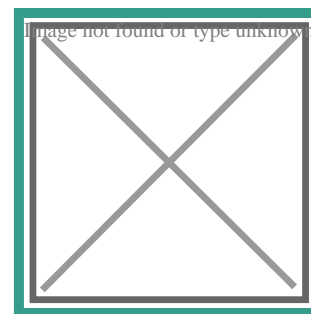


Debbie Hannan

Debbie writes and directs for stage and screen. They are a Scottish freelance writer/director who has been developing and directing new plays for 15 years, alongside their own writing and screen work. They are known for dynamic, high energy, heightened work, focussing on LGBTQ+, disabled and working-class stories, with a love for dark, social satire. Based mainly between London and Glasgow, they work nationally and internationally. They are currently Associate Artist at Cardboard Citizens and were formerly Associate Director at National Theatre of Scotland, Incoming Artistic Director of the Traverse Theatre, Interim Artistic Director and Showrunner at Stockroom, theatre's first writers room. They trained at the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland and as Trainee Director at the Royal Court, and has recently joined the board of Theatre Uncut. Debbie has directed at theatres such as the Royal Court Theatre, the Unicorn, the Young Vic, the Bush Theatre, Soho Theatre, the Royal Exchange (Manchester), the Tron Theatre (Glasgow), the Citizens Theatre (Glasgow), the Traverse Theatre (Edinburgh) and with companies such as Complicité, Clean Break, Sonia Friedman Productions and Paines Plough, including winning an Olivier as Associate Director for Best Revival of Constellations on the West End. Debbie received the Genesis New Director's Award, and an MGC Futures Bursary. As a writer, they have been commissioned by Cardboard Citizens for the More Than One Story project, who then produced their award-winning short Snakes and Landlords. Debbie was also shortlisted for the Alpine Fellowship Playwriting Award, is writing a new musical developed by Northern Stage, and adapted a children's book, Beegu, for the Unicorn Theatre. For screen, Debbie has directed a short produced by Film4 and 104 Films, co-written with Matilda Ibini, which screened at London Film Festival 2023. They were Shadow Director on Shetland Season 6 & 7, and are developing a feature on a BFI Creative Challenge Lab. They have been co-commissioned by Fable Pictures and is a finalist in the Studio21 Pilot award. Debbie is currently developing their first feature, with research supported by the Miles Ketley Memorial Fund.
