Kerry Godliman is a critically acclaimed actor and comedian whose sharp wit and warmth have made her a distinctive voice in British entertainment. She was most recently in cinemas in *Spinal Tap II: The End Continues*, the long-awaited sequel directed by Rob Reiner. On television, Kerry stars in the title role of *Whitstable Pearl*, now in its third season, and as Sonia in ITV's hit drama *Trigger Point*. She will next be seen in the upcoming Netflix series *The Witness*. Kerry is best known to global audiences for her performance as Lisa in Ricky Gervais's acclaimed Netflix series *After Life*, appearing across all three seasons. Other work also includes *The Undeclared War* (Channel 4/Peacock), *Adult Material* (Channel 4/HBO Max), two seasons of *Save Me* (Sky Atlantic/Peacock), and *Treadstone* (Amazon). Alongside her acting career, Kerry is an established name in British comedy. A regular face on national panel shows, she brings her trademark humour and relatability to both stage and screen. She co-hosts the popular podcast *Memory Lane* with comedian Jen Brister, exploring nostalgia and personal stories with celebrity guests.
