KATE PHILLIPS is currently shooting the film adaptation of THE WEIR opposite Brendan Gleeson, directed by Conor McPherson. Last autumn she performed in the stage version at the Harold Pinter Theatre west end, for which she received a Best Newcomer nomination at the Critics' Circle Theatre Awards 2026. She will next shoot her final season of MISS SCARLET playing the title role, for which she is also executive producer. Kate was also recently seen on PBS Masterpiece/BBC in Peter Kosminsky's WOLF HALL – THE MIRROR & THE LIGHT playing 'Jane Seymour'. This last year she also worked on feature films BLACK NOISE and THE YELLOW TIE, leading as 'Ioana' opposite John Malkovich, Ben Schnetzer and Miranda Richardson – both out soon.

TV highlights include: HIJACK opposite Idris Elba for Apple, four seasons of PEAKY BLINDERS as 'Linda Shelby' and THE CROWN. Kate debuted as 'Jane Seymour' in Peter Kosminsky's WOLF HALL and was a Screen International Star of Tomorrow 2014.-

In film, Kate played 'Hester Gatty' opposite Jack Lowden in the Terence Davies BFI/EMU/BBC Films feature BENEDICTION. Other film highlights include: as 'Princess Mary' in the DOWNTON ABBEY feature film, THE AFTERMATH with Keira Knightley and Alexander Skarsgård, and Lenny Abrahamson's THE LITTLE STRANGER.
