He was named a Skillset 'Trailblazer' at the Edinburgh Film Festival and invited to the Berlin Film Festival's Berlinale Talent Campus. His original screenplays have been selected for the prestigious Atelier de Scenario Franco-Britannique at the Dinard Film Festival, and MEDIA's 'Passion To Market' Programme. He has also won the NFTS 'Christie' Prize and the UKFC's '25 Words or Less' Competition. Before becoming a screenwriter, David was a successful Stand-up Comic, performing in several sell-out Edinburgh shows. Prior to that he worked at Picador Books in New York and for Ogilvy Advertising in London. He earned a First in English at the University of Leeds and a Fulbright Award to the University of California, Berkeley. He now lives in London with his wife, two children and Final Draft 8.
