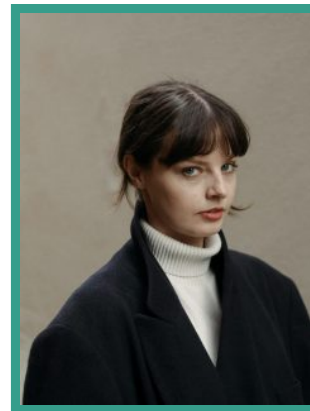

Josephine Lohoar Self is a British writer and director working across film & television. Her first short film, *The Fabric of You*, was longlisted for the Academy Awards in 2021 and received a Scottish BAFTA nomination.

Josephine has since directed a series of shorts, winning and earning nominations from the Royal Television Society and the Irish Film and Television Awards. Josephine is currently developing her first feature film, the historical drama *The Wall Dogs*, produced by Weydemann Bros. and Cardel Entertainment, and recently completed post-production on her BFI-funded short *Daddy's Girl*.

Josephine is an alumna of BFI NETWORK@LFF, Berlinale Talents, the Scottish Film Talent Network, and the Edinburgh International Film Festival Talent Lab. Josephine has also served on juries for BAFTA Scotland and Palm Springs ShortFest.
